



## SAFETY AND RESTRICTIONS AT HUIMA ADVENTURE PARK

### Safety

On the adventure courses, our customers must wear personal protective equipment and fall arrest systems. They put on a full harness and helmet and are secured with Edelrid Smart Belay systems so that the adventurer is always clipped to the safety cable. At the beginning, the instructor familiarises the customers with the equipment and, when the instructions are followed, the system guarantees a safe and fulfilling adventure experience.

Our adventure courses have undergone an independent TUV A audit in accordance with standard SFS-EN 15567-1; the entire park is type approved and CE certified. The adventure courses are maintained according to the requirements of the standard.

Our adventure course instructors are trained to safely guide all customer segments and to act in unusual and rescue situations in accordance with standard SFS-EN 15567-2.

### Restrictions on participants

Minimum height for the children's course: 110 cm, *recommendation 120 cm*

Minimum height for the family courses (green, yellow, orange, red): 125 cm

Minimum height for the teen courses (light blue, blue, violet, brown): 140 cm

Maximum weight: 125 kg

If you have any health issues or reduced mobility, please speak to the instructor about your opportunities to participate:

- e.g. musculoskeletal disorders; recently operated knees, shoulders, etc.
- respiratory and circulatory diseases, myocarditis, pregnancy + 4 months, epilepsy, etc.

Children under the age of 14 can only go on adventures in the presence of their parent/guardian.

14–17-year-olds must bring a rules form signed by their parent/guardian.



Persons who are 18 or older can go on adventures once they understand the rules and sign the form to show that they undertake to follow all of them.

### **Condition restrictions**

Adventures in nature pose restrictions on activities which may force the adventure park to be closed partly or fully.

Grounds for closing the courses:

- Thunderstorm
- Heavy rainfall
- High winds = wind warning for land areas of gusts at 15 m/s (yellow/over 6 on the Beaufort scale)
- Frozen/slippery structures
- Temperatures below  $-10\text{ C}^{\circ}$

It may be necessary to close a course or all the courses in the park due to weather or another unusual circumstance. Purchased tickets will not be exchanged or refunded.

We recommend all adventurers to read the rules before coming to the park. It is a good idea to print and fill in the adventure rules form in advance – that saves a lot of time for adventures!
